



HALLOWEEN DURING THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PANDEMIC

Avoid typical trick-or-treating. Instead, households should offer individually wrapped treat bags left at the end of the driveway to allow for social distancing.



Parties should be held outside. Protective face coverings, not costume masks, should be worn. All guests should practice proper social distancing of at least 6 feet from non-household members.



Do not visit haunted houses. Often these do not allow for proper social distancing or adequate ventilation. Also, if people are screaming, more than 6 feet of distance is recommended.



Stay at home if possible. Decorate pumpkins and/or watch a scary movie with your household members. Have a virtual costume party. If you have children, hide candy around your house for a fun and active scavenger hunt.
